The Taleghani Garden, with its abundant plant species, houses the tallest Middle Eastern flag tower and also connects to the western part of Abbas Abad through the nature bridge.



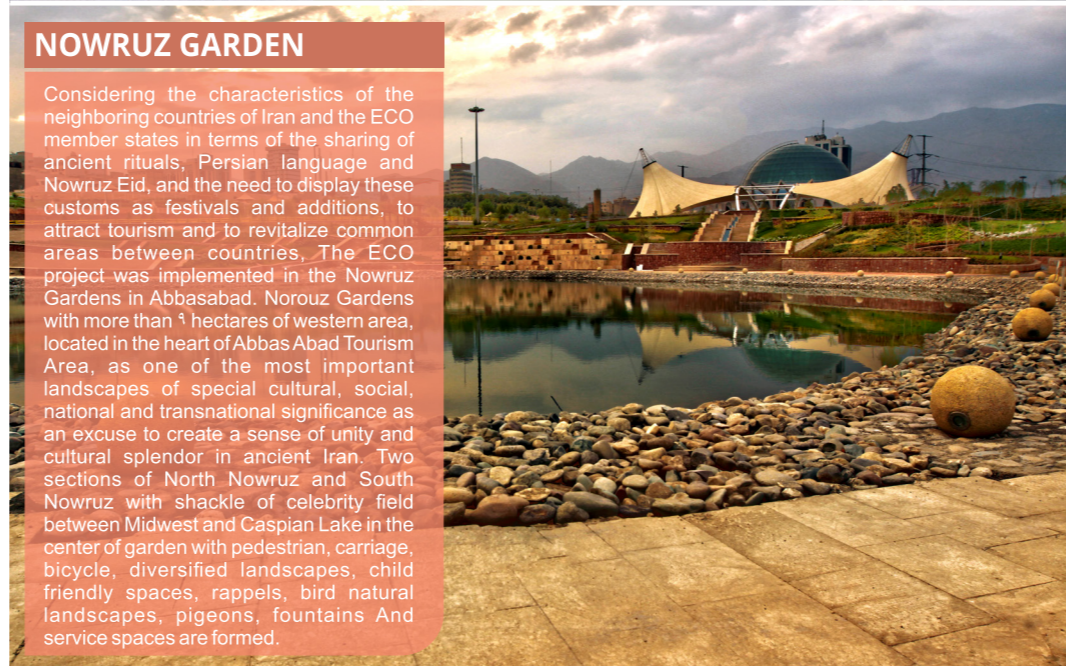
CRUISES GARDENS (Ports)

The 53,000-square-meters Cruises Garden is one of Abbas Abad's most popular gardens, built with lush landscapes and marine structures and symbols. The presence of port and cruise ship building has made symbolic use of elements such as lantern tower, boat, dock, harbor hangar, wide green areas of low altitude with a wide area to convey the sea to the audience.



NOWRUZ GARDEN

Considering the characteristics of the neighboring countries of Iran and the ECO member states in terms of the sharing of ancient rituals, Persian language and Nowruz Eid, and the need to display these customs as festivals and additions, to attract tourism and to revitalize common areas between countries, The ECO project was implemented in the Nowruz Gardens in Abbasabad. Norouz Gardens with more than 1 hectares of western area, located in the heart of Abbas Abad Tourism Area, as one of the most important landscapes of special cultural, social, national and transnational significance as an excuse to create a sense of unity and cultural splendor in ancient Iran. Two sections of North Nowruz and South Nowruz with shackle of celebrity field between Midwest and Caspian Lake in the center of garden with pedestrian, carriage, bicycle, diversified landscapes, child friendly spaces, rappels, bird natural landscapes, pigeons, fountains And service spaces are formed.



MINA DOME

The Garden of the Solar System is the place where the Mina dome is located. The Solar System Garden was designed and implemented as a center for the dissemination of science in various disciplines for all age groups with different levels of science. The garden geometry is centered on the skyline dome of the sun with the use of Iranian-Islamic architectural elements and circular shaped circular platforms as planets around it. The Mina Dome comprises three main sections of the Exhibition and Gallery of Science, the Movie Hall, and the installation rings, which are used as a functional belt around the Exhibition Dome in the Science Exhibition Area.
